Activities:

- A programme to distribute fruit trees to the residents of Rangibasan village was conducted today. Rangibasan is one of the adopted village of our college for the Unnat Bharat Abhayan programme.
- For the benefit of the local environment as well as the health and nutrition of the villagers, a number of fruit trees were distributed to the selected families today.
- The selection of the families was primarily based on the economic status of the families. In order to minimise the number of families, those whose children attend Rangibasan Primary School were specifically selected. At the same time, these families belong to the BPL category.
- This year, it was decided that only lemon trees should be given away. The lemon tree was chosen because it is planted primarily for its high nutritional value.
- Dr Basudev Panda, HOD, Sanskrit, Mahishadal Girls' College was the chief guest for today's programme. He distributed some trees to the villagers. The headmaster and other teachers of Rangibasan Prathamik Vidyalaya were also present at the programme.
