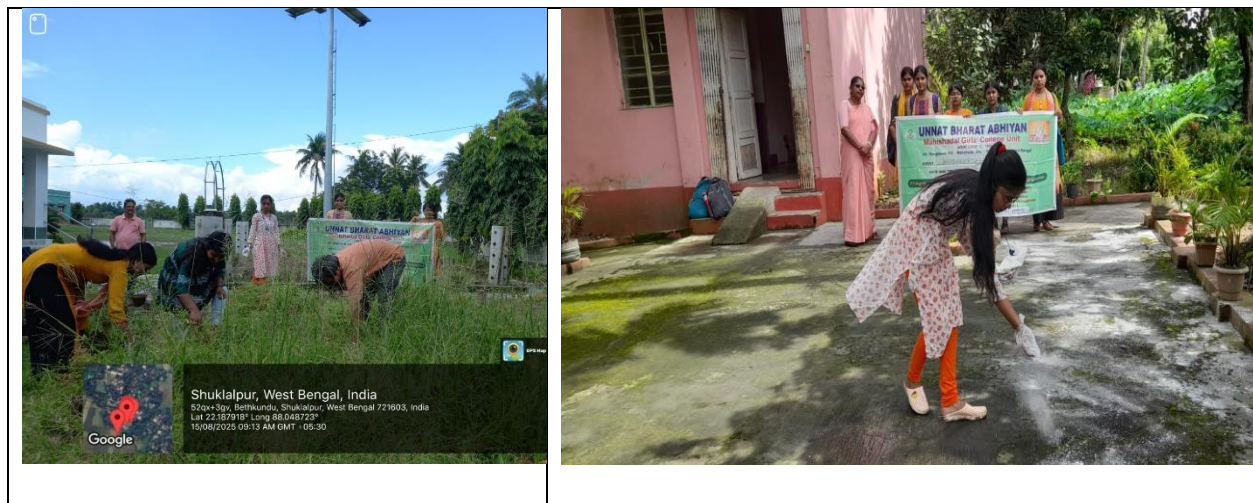

Activity details:

To honour the contribution of the great freedom fighters in the freedom movement, their great activities were discussed.
